





Blueberry type:	Rabbit Eye	
Released:	2009	
Key attributes:	Centra Blue is a very late medium chill variety with very good production, decent size and superior eating quality. Chosen for its outstanding fruit quality with a very attractive bloom on the fruit, little grittiness and an exceptionally late fruiting season.	
Chilling Required:	Medium (400-600h < 7.2C)	
Flowering:	Late Spring (50% late September) PDF = 120 Days	
Pollinator:	Sky/Velutto Blue	
Bud break:	First visible leafs starting early September.	
Harvest:	Very late; start ripening the first week of February until end of March. Has an extended fruiting season.	
Plant Vigour:	Crown like Northern High Bush, very vigorous & precocious	
Yield:	Highly Productive, averaging approximately 10.5 Kg (observed range 8.1–14.4 Kg) per plant (25-35 ton/ha in full production)	
Berry size:	Medium to large average 16-18mm size and averaging 2.2 g	
Fruit shape:	Oblong to round	
Colour:	Light blue; blue black with bloom removed	
Bloom:	Strong; light blue	
Picking Scar:	Small/Medium dry scar

Firmness:	Firm with good shelf life	
Flavour:	Very good, level averaged 11.4% (observed range 9.6– 13.8 Brix). The fruit acidity measured as titratable acidity averaged 3.8 mg/g.	
Disease:	The plant does not seem to be susceptible to rust.	
Other:	No damage from rain
