Key attributes: The fruit of Sunset Blue is medium to large, with

strong bloom, good flavor with a good balance between sugar and acidity, and extended shelf life. Plant is upright with good vigor and an early heavy

crop.

Chilling Required: Medium (+800h < 7.2C)

Flowering: Spring (50% early September) PDF = 85 Days

Pollinator: Blue Moon

Bud break: First visible leafs starting early September.

Harvest: Mid-season, from mid-November until end of

December

Plant Vigour: Vigorous upright growth

Yield: Good, averaging approximately 4kg per plant

(15-25 ton/ha in full production)

Berry size: Medium to large: average approximately 16.3 mm

(observed range 14.7-17.5 mm), 2.2g aver weight

Fruit shape: Fruit is oblate in shape

Colour: Medium blue, sometimes shows red back

Bloom: Strong; light blue

Picking Scar: Small/Medium dry scar







Firmness: Moderate to very firm

Flavour: Good flavor with balanced taste. Brix level averages

11.4%, (observed range 9-13%)

Disease: The plant does not seem to be susceptible to rust

(Pucciniastrum vaccinii).
