Raspberries

Raspberry type:	Double cropping primocane
Released:	2019
Key attributes:	Skye is a late-season primocane variety with the potential to double crop in summertime. Berries can be picked at an early pink stage, making it ideal for export. The variety is suited for long cane production in combination with cold storage.
Thorns:	Yes, small
Chilling Required:	Medium (1000-1200h < 7.2C) Cold storage compatible.
Flowering:	Autumn flush March to April, Spring flush October to November.
Harvest:	Late-season primocane. Mid-March to end of May. Summer harvest late Dec to early Feb.
Plant Vigour:	Strong upright growing canes that can reach 2m easily, ideal for long cane production.
Berry size:	Average fruit size of 5,8g on autumn crop, 4,8g on summer crop.
Fruit shape:	Long and pointy
Colour:	Light, peachy red that maintains colour during shipping.
Ease of picking:	Fruit detaches easily when picked on the light pink side.





Skye

Firmness:	Firm with good shelf life.
Flavour:	Average 10,8 Brix. Skye has a strong aromatic taste and is well balanced between sweetness and acidity.
